

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

## **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 04 March 2022, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 31 March 2022, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at their last inspection.

During the visit, we found the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of child protection procedures and now fully understands their responsibilities. There are effective procedures in place to ensure the premises are safe and secure. The provider has ensured that accurate and sufficiently detailed records are kept for each child in their care. They have implemented an effective key person system to ensure the care and learning needs of all children can be met. Staff have received training on how to manage children's behaviour appropriately so that they remain safe and their emotional need are met. The provider has ensured staff are deployed effectively to supervise children so that they remain safe and are provided with quality care experiences. They has taken account of current guidance and reinforced the importance of following hygiene procedures to promote the good health of children. This helps to ensure the safe and effective management of the nursery.



We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
