

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the [Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage](#). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 22 February 2022 we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 15 March 2022 we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at their last inspection.

We found that the provider has taken appropriate action to ensure that children are appropriately supervised at all times, by ensuring that staff are always present in areas used by children. The provider had made changes to the outdoor area to remove risks to children's safety and improved risk assessment procedures. Food hygiene and fire safety arrangements have also been reviewed and improved. The provider has improved their understanding of when to liaise with other agencies with regards to allegations made against individuals working with children. The provider has strengthened their own and staff's awareness understanding of the safer sleep guidelines. The arrangements for babies and young children to sleep within the nursery had also been reviewed and alterations made.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
