

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 11 March 2022, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 1 April 2022, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection.

We found that the provider had taken action to improve staff's knowledge and understanding of safeguarding issues, including the procedures to follow if they have concerns about the conduct of other members of staff. Staff have received training in behaviour management. They demonstrate a suitable understanding of appropriate ways to manage children's behaviour. Improvements have been made to the arrangements for the supervision for staff. Staff have a better understanding of their roles and responsibilities. Improvements have been made to the key person system. All staff working with children have had suitable criminal records checks completed.

The provider has taken satisfactory action to meet the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
