

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

Outcome summary:

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 1 April 2022, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 21 April 2022, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection. We found the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions. They have addressed the weaknesses in the security of the building to ensure that unauthorised visitors cannot access the nursery. The provider has ensured that ratios are adhered to across the nursery. The provider has provided further child protection support and training for staff, who demonstrated a clear understanding of the appropriate safeguarding procedures to follow. The provider has reviewed the leadership teams and the deployment of staff to ensure that staff are deployed effectively across the nursery. Children are well supervised and their needs were met. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the

enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
