

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 7 April 2022, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 13 May 2022, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had informed Ofsted of her assistant and had taken steps to ensure that all required checks were completed. She had reduced the number of children she was caring for until the required checks were satisfactorily completed, and her assistant was not included in the staff to child ratios. The provider ensured that children's attendance each day was recorded. The provider had introduced systems for monitoring her assistant's performance and had identified training opportunities that supported her knowledge and skills.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
