

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 10 March 2022 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 8 April 2022, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We issued a notice to improve. This is a notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the times scales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 6 May 2022:

develop a secure understanding of the possible signs of abuse and neglect and the procedures to follow in the event of a child protection concern

develop knowledge of wider safeguarding issues, including all aspects of the 'Prevent' duty guidance

develop a secure understanding of how to respond and report allegations of serious harm or abuse by any person living, working, or looking after children at the premises

ensure appropriate public liability insurance to cover all premises from which childcare is provided

ensure a full current paediatric first aid certificate is maintained.

The provider resigned their registration with Ofsted on 6 June 2022.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our

responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
