Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a secure understanding of how children learn. She confidently discusses a range of activities and experiences aimed at promoting all areas of learning. She has experience of successfully identifying children's learning needs and planning suitably challenging activities.
- The premises are well organised and attractively presented, indoors and outdoors. The childminder has a large selection of well-maintained, attractively presented toys and resources.
- The childminder demonstrates a clear knowledge of how to support children to behave well. She recognises the impact that the COVID-19 pandemic has had on children's emotional well-being and has fully considered how she would support individual children.
- There are appropriate systems in place to maintain all required documentation.
- The childminder has a comprehensive knowledge of her responsibilities to safeguard children. She is aware of the signs that may indicate that a child is at risk and knows the procedure to follow to report any concerns. The childminder has a written safeguarding policy, as required.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
