

## **Complaint about childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at

[www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

We received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 20 June 2022, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right.

The provider has improved the procedures to promote children's good health. The provider has reviewed the drinking facilities available to children and has also implemented training for staff, to update their awareness of food hygiene practices.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
