

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundationstage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundationstage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 17 June 2022, the provider notified us that a child had left the premises unsupervised. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events

On 24 June 2022, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements as a child had been able to leave the premises unsupervised. However, the provider had acted promptly to minimise the risk of this happening in the future. They made adjustments to the exit gate to remove a 'climbing' risk. They raised the height of the wall. In addition, they revisited their risk assessment and considered the deployment and vigilance of staff. They also increased the frequency of head counts.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
