

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 25 April 2022, the provider notified us of a significant event relating to an injury to a child and on 13 May 2022, the provider notified us of a further significant event relating to security of the premises. These notifications mean that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant changes or events.

On 22 June 2022 we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 29/06/2022:

- ensure paediatric trained staff administer the appropriate first aid to children as required
- improve the effectiveness of staff supervision so that staff practice is monitored and appropriate support and training is given to staff to help them understand their roles and responsibilities, in particular when taking action in the event of an injury to a child and when administering first aid treatment
- improve staff deployment to ensure that children are appropriately supervised at all times.

The provider subsequently took the appropriate action. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply

with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
