

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 29 March 2022, the provider notified us of an allegation made against a staff member. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage' to notify Ofsted of any allegations made against a person working at the premises.

We conducted a telephone call with the provider, and found that the provider had not met all of the requirements because staff had failed to follow the setting's safeguarding policy and procedure. However, the provider had taken steps to address this by completing a thorough investigation, and undertaking additional training so that all staff are clear about their responsibilities to follow the safeguarding procedure in the future. We were satisfied that the provider had taken appropriate action and took no further action.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to



bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
