

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 9 May 2022, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 7 June 2022, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection.

We found that the provider had improved arrangements for supervision of staff so that weaknesses in staff development were being addressed through, support, coaching and training. Fire exits had been cleared and were accessible in the event of a fire. The provider had reviewed the deployment of staff to ensure all children were being kept safe. The provider had reviewed risk assessments for the outdoor area. They have a system in place to ensure children's attendance is being recorded accurately. The provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of incidents and changes that need to be notified to Ofsted.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
