

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

Date concerns received: 07/02/2022; Concerns received from: Inclusion officer; Summary of concerns: Concerns that children with SEND are not being provided with effective and proactive support, concerns that children whose behaviour is a concern are not promptly referred to other agencies, concerns about the organisation of the snack time routine and how it supports children's independence and well-being; Relevant requirements/ legislation: Learning and development requirements, Child protection, Food and drink; How did we investigate: Regulatory visit; Breaches found linked to the concerns: Support for some children with identified delays in their development do not receive timely and proactive targeted support to help them move on to the next stage in their learning or catch up with their peers; Action taken Ofsted to rectify breaches: NTI - Review the systems in place to ensure that all children who are identified as needing additional help to move on to the next stage in their learning receive targeted support at the earliest possible stage; Did provider comply/ how was this monitored: telephone call held with provider who confirmed that they had taken steps to make sure that those at risk of falling behind their peers and or/with identified SEN/D; **Inspection timescale at conclusion of case:** in line with normal timeframes or should any concerns be received which warrant a priority inspection.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.
