

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2 If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 26 May 2021, we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. On the 30 July 2021 we carried out regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the action below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed by 9 August 2021

ensure there is at least one member of staff with a full and relevant level 3 qualification, and at least half of all other staff hold a full and relevant level 2 qualification caring for children age two and under at all times

The provider responded to our actions letter by 11 August 2021. We found that the provider had taken appropriate action.

Publication of complaints
