

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 8 August 2022, we received a notification from the provider about an incident where a child's allergy requirements were not met. This notification means that the provider met their legal obligations to notify Ofsted of a significant event as soon as reasonably practicable or within 14 days of the event occurring.

On 9 August 2022, we carried out a telephone call to the provider. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. In particular, the provider had not made sure that children do not have contact with food to which they are allergic to. We were satisfied that the provider had taken immediate steps to address the breach of the requirements by ensuring that additional checks are undertaken for all ingredients for meals in the future. In addition, the provider reviewed and updated care plans in place to make sure that children's individual needs are met at all times.

We were satisfied with the action taken by the provider to address the breach of the requirements and did not need to take any further action ourselves. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
