Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder knows how to plan age-appropriate activities and outings to promote children's progress. She aims to offer children a variety of suitable toys and resources to help them with their learning.
- The childminder intends to support children's growth and development. For example, she plans to teach children about the benefits of exercise and a balanced diet.
- The childminder describes how she will work with parents to establish a consistent approach in children's care and education. She understands the importance of involving parents and other professionals in the self-evaluation process.
- The childminder ensures all her mandatory training is up to date. She expresses her commitment to her professional development.
- The childminder knows how to keep children safe and secure. She is aware of what to do if she is concerned about a child's welfare, including if they are being drawn into radicalisation. There are appropriate procedures for recording and reporting any safeguarding concerns.
- The childminder recognises the importance of promoting positive behaviour. She aims to teach children to respect others and the environment.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- This was the first routine inspection the setting received since the COVID-19 pandemic began. The inspector discussed the impact of the pandemic with the provider and has taken that into account in their evaluation of the setting.
- The inspector held a number of discussions with the childminder. She looked at relevant documentation and evidence of the suitability of persons living in the household.
- The childminder showed the inspector around the setting and explained how she intends to use the play areas for childminding purposes.
- The inspector checked the toys and resources that will be made available for the children. She talked to the childminder about the risk assessment procedures.
