

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 16 June 2022, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 8 July 2022, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. The focus of the call was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection.

We found that the provider ensures that children are cared for only by those who are registered to do so and that their suitability has been appropriately verified. The provider has obtained the appropriate permission from parents to leave children with an assistant for no longer than two hours in any one day. The provider ensures that daily records of arrival and departure times of children are consistently maintained.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
