Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- Leaders understand how to plan a wide range of activities which are appropriate for children in the early years age range. The manager explains that he works with parents to build upon children's interests and learning.
- Staff understand how to promote children's positive behaviour. They describe how children are supported to manage their feelings and behaviour. Staff have high expectations for children's behaviour. The manager explains how staff encourage the children to follow simple instructions.
- The manager speaks passionately about his vision for all children to be valued and included. The manager explains that he involves all children in discussions, and considers their views when planning activities.
- The provider has safe recruitment procedures in place to ensure that all practitioners are suitable to fulfil their roles. The manager and staff undertake regular safeguarding training. They recognise the signs which may indicate that a child is at risk, and know the action they should take.
- The manager understands how to promote children's health and well-being. Children are encouraged to bring in healthy snacks and packed lunches. Staff plan regular physical activities and visits. For instance, children visit parks and a large soft-play area. The manager explains how staff understand that the children need plenty of opportunities to socialise with others. Most staff have appropriate first-aid training.
- Leaders and staff explain that they feel valued and supported by the provider. Staff have access to regular training to extend their knowledge and skills. The manager holds regular supervision sessions and appraisals to help practitioners identify how they might improve their practice.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
