

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 11 August 2022, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 6 September 2022, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection.

We found that the provider had improved their recruitment procedures to ensure staff are suitable to work with children. They had made improvements to the security of the premises to prevent unauthorised persons entering the nursery. A new key-person system had been implemented to ensure children's individual needs are met. They had improved the procedure for staff support, monitoring, and coaching.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
