## Summary of key findings

### This provision meets requirements

- The provider understands the importance to seek the views of children, parents and staff to help them evaluate the practice to improve provision for all children in their care.
- The provider has effective systems in place to ensure the suitability of staff working with children. These include thorough recruitment, induction, and regular supervision and support for staff.
- The provider and staff understand their duty to protect children's welfare. They know how to identify the signs of abuse and neglect and have a good understanding of wider safeguarding concerns, including the 'Prevent' duty guidance. The provider and staff are aware of where to report concerns and what to do if an allegation of abuse was made against a member of staff.
- The provider and staff know how to provide high-quality experiences to complement learning for individual children, including those with special educational needs and/or disabilities. They work in close partnership with parents and the host school to benefit children. The provider and staff understand the importance of effective information sharing to provide consistency in children's care, learning and development.
- The provider has appropriate resources to support children's learning and development.
- Staff know how to support children's good health and well-being. For example, they encourage children to be active, including outdoors, and provide healthy and nutritious diet, including breakfast and tea.
- The provider and staff know how to manage children's behaviour effectively. In addition, they believe in the importance of teaching children about using good manners and respecting each other's differences.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

The club opens each weekday from 7.45am to 9am and from 3.15pm to 6pm, during term time only. The provider employs five members of staff, four of whom hold relevant childcare qualifications.

## Inspection activities

- This is the first routine inspection the provider has received since the COVID-19 pandemic began. The inspector discussed the impact of the pandemic with the provider and has taken that into account in their evaluation of the provider.
- The inspector had discussions with the nominated individual and staff about their understanding of how to safeguard children and support their learning.
- The inspector viewed the provision and discussed the safety and suitability of the premises.
- The inspector looked at documentation relating to the suitability of those working with children, including Disclosure and Barring Service checks and first-aid certificates.

We carried out this inspection under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the early years foundation stage.

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
