## Summary of key findings

### This provision meets requirements

- The manager explains how staff will provide a broad and balanced curriculum to help children learn. She discusses how staff will assess children's progress and use this information to identify their current stage of development and plan for their next steps in learning.
- The manager understands her role to implement the safeguarding and welfare requirements, including how staff will recognise and report any allegations of abuse as well as wider safeguarding issues. The manager explains how staff will provide a safe and secure environment for children.
- The manager knows how to support staff to promote positive behaviour. This includes helping children to manage their own feelings and to be considerate towards others.
- The manager discusses how staff will discuss the importance of bringing in healthy packed lunches and snacks and remind children to wash their hands before they eat. She explains the benefits of children understanding the effects of exercise on their bodies.
- The manager explains how staff will establish close relationships with parents from the start. She discusses the importance of sharing updates with parents about their children's experiences, such as through their daily discussions and termly meetings. The manager understands the importance of making links with local schools to promote continuity of care.
- The manager explains she has a recruitment, induction, and supervision process to ensure staff are suitable to work with children. She understands the importance of holding regular meetings and providing targeted coaching and effective support to her staff team. She states she has strategies in place to help reduce their workload and discusses the positive impact this will have on staff's well-being.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
