

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2.

If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On the 16th of September 2022, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements the overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On the 3rd of October 2022, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at their last inspection. During the visit we found the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions. However, we found a new area of concern. This means that the provider was not meeting other requirements as set out in the statutory framework for the early years foundation stage.

In relation to the new area of concern on 4th of October 2022, we issued an action for the provider to take.

action needed by 11th of October 2022:

- ensure the nominated individual and other committee members understand the setting safeguarding policy, including knowing how to manage an allegation and reporting

processes in line with local safeguarding partnership procedures.

On 12 October 2022, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of child protection procedures and now fully understands their responsibilities. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted
