

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2.

If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 9 and 17 August 2022, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 22 and 24 August 2022, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have served a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 27 September 2022:

- ensure essential information is swiftly shared with parents, particularly when their child has been involved in an accident or incident at the setting
- ensure policies and procedures are effectively implemented, particularly with regard to accidents and injuries
- ensure all staff have appropriate training and knowledge needed in order to fulfil their roles and responsibilities, including those acting as co-ordinators for provision for children with special educational needs and/or disabilities
- ensure appropriate arrangements are in place to meet the needs of all children, including those with special educational needs and/or disabilities

On 4 October 2022, we carried out a compliance visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised following the regulatory telephone call. We found that the provider had taken prompt and effective action to address the identified breaches of requirements.

We are satisfied with the action taken by the provider and no further action was required by

Ofsted on this matter. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
