

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 31 October 2022 we received a concern that the provider was not meeting some of those requirements. On 1 November 2022, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. Risk assessment for the furniture in the rooms where children play has been improved. For example, a rug has been placed beside the sofa and children must be always seated with a member of staff. The provider has also reviewed the procedures for managing accidents and when a child arrives with an injury. Ofsted are satisfied with the action taken. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
