

## Compliance action taken for childcare provision

## **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 4 October 2022, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

The report and inspection outcome will be published in due course. Following the inspection we served a welfare requirements notice on 21 October 2022. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 1 November 2022:

- implement robust risk assessments to ensure that the setting is safe and suitable for children and that the premises are secure
- improve accident procedures to check any injuries that children may have incurred while at the setting and keep a written record of accidents or injuries and inform parents on the same day or as soon as reasonably practicable.

On 10 November 2022, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at their last inspection.

We found that the provider had improved their use of risk of risk assessment and has taken appropriate action to ensure that the premises are now secure. They have improved their practices for attending to children when they sustain any accidents or injuries and now have systems in place to record this information promptly. The provider demonstrates an understanding of how and when to share any information about accidents or injuries that children sustain on the same day or as soon as reasonably practicable.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The



provider is still registered with Ofsted.
