

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2)

If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 07 July 2022, we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 17 October 2022 we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take.

Action needed by 04 November 2022:

- maintain a record of the names and hours of attendance of all children being cared for on the premises
  
- make sure required documentation is easily accessible and available for Ofsted to view, with particular reference to that which demonstrates the suitability of staff to work with children.

Action needed by 11 November 2022:

- ensure there is a named deputy manager in place, who has been assessed as capable and qualified, to take charge in the absence of the manger.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

On 02 November 2022, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had refreshed staff's knowledge about the importance of maintaining children's attendance records. She has ensured that there is a named deputy in place. The provider will ensure that necessary documentation is readily available for Ofsted to view.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
