

## **Complaint about childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 October 2022, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage.

On 16 and 24 November 2022 we carried out regulatory telephone calls. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has recruited additional qualified staff to ensure they can meet staff: children ratios at all times.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of complaints**

We publish details of complaints made against childminders, home childcarers and childcare providers where we or the provider have taken action in order to meet legal requirements.
