

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundationstage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 29 November 2022, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. On 1 December 2022, the provider notified us of an incident relating to this concern. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of any significant event which is likely to affect the suitability of the early years provider or any person who cares for or is in contact with children on the premises.

On 5 December 2022, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 16 December 2022

- ensure that those responsible for preparing and handling food are trained in food hygiene
- ensure written permission is obtained from parents and/or carers, of any medication administered to children
- ensure evidence is recorded of parents being notified when medication is administered.

The provider responded satisfactorily. They had located the written permission for medication to be administered and they reviewed their medication records to include more information and obtain parents signatures after the medication had been administered. They also ensured all responsible for handling food had food safety training,

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.
