

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 14 December 2022, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 23 December 2022, we carried out a regulatory telephone call and had further email communications. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider ensured that they have at least one person who has a current paediatric first aid (PFA) certificate on the premises and available at all times when children are present. The provider had also improved systems to monitor the expiration of other compulsory courses to remain compliant at all times.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted
