## **Summary of key findings**

#### This provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands how children learn. She knows how to plan activities to meet their interests and developmental needs and how to assess their progress. The childminder is committed to work with parents to make sure children receive consistency in their care and learning.
- The childminder recognises the importance of providing children with daily fresh air and a variety of opportunities to practise their physical skills and learn about healthy lifestyles.
- The childminder has a sound understanding of how to safeguard children. She is fully aware of the signs of abuse or neglect. She knows the procedures she must follow if she has any concerns about a child and shares her policy with the parents.
- The childminder is aware of how to promote children's good behaviour and social skills. She also understands the importance of teaching children to respect different cultures and other people's way of life.
- The childminder is committed to support children to be independent and ready for their next step in learning.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
