

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 8 November, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 6 December 2022, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at their last inspection.

We found that the provider has improved their knowledge of their role and responsibilities, including notifying safeguarding concerns to the relevant agencies in a timely manner. The provider has introduced a new policy and developed practice that supports children's personal development. Improvements to the recruitment procedures to ensure it includes thorough vetting processes for all staff. Steps have been taken to improve risk assessments to provide children with a safe learning environment.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
