

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 22 November 2022, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 5 January 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at their last inspection. We found the provider had met all of the safeguarding and welfare actions. For instance, the provider improved their recruitment procedures and ensures staff, including volunteers, whose suitability checks have not been fully cleared or completed, do not provide any personal care to children. The provider also improved supervision arrangements for staff and provides opportunities for professional development to improve staff's teaching skills and to ensure they have clear knowledge and understanding of their roles and responsibilities, and follow the nursery's policies and procedures.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
