

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 3 February 2023, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 13 February 2023, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. They took part in a meeting with the Designated Officer for Allegations (DOFA) and an early years advisor from the local authority. This increased their understanding of when they need to refer allegations against staff to the DOFA and when they need to notify Ofsted.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
