## Summary of key findings

### This provision meets requirements

- The management team and staff are aware of their duty to safeguard children. They are confident in the signs and indicators of abuse and fully understand the procedures to follow if they have any child protection concerns.
- The management team and staff provide an inclusive play environment for the children. They understand how to provide activities that interest the children and meet their individual needs.
- Staff know the importance of maintaining communication with parents, which helps them to know and understand about children's backgrounds and individual needs. The management team encourages feedback from parents and children to help them shape and improve the club.
- The management team and staff understand how to support children's behaviour. They have agreed rules with the children to help them understand the behaviour expectations. Staff understand how to promote children's health. For example, they ensure the provision is clean and provide nutritious snacks and meals for the children to enjoy.
- The management team and staff understand the importance of having good partnerships with other professionals involved in children's care. This helps them to promote continuity in children's care and learning.
- The documentation used by staff is detailed and sufficient to meet the requirements of the early years foundation stage. The management team understands the importance of offering staff ongoing training opportunities to enhance and support their professional development.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Vicky's After School & Holiday Club Limited re-registered in 2020. It operates from Ducklington C Of E New Primary School, Witney, Oxfordshire. The club offers after-school care Monday to Thursday, from 3pm until 6pm. The club employs three staff members. Of these, one member of staff has qualifications at level 3, and two are unqualified.

### Inspection activities

- The inspector spoke to leaders and staff about how they safeguard children and meet the individual needs of the children.
