

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 29 January 2023, we received a notification from the provider of a significant event.

On 2 February 2023, we carried out unannounced visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take.

Actions needed by 20 February 2023:

ensure children cannot leave the premises unsupervised

ensure children are adequately supervised at all times, in particular regard to when children use the outdoor area

ensure robust risk assessments are in place, and followed, to prevent children being exposed to risks.

On 20 February 2023, the provider responded to the action/s set. We found that the provider had reviewed their risk assessment and supervision procedures. We are satisfied the provider has met the actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action



We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.
