

## Compliance action taken for childcare provision

## **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2 If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On the 12 January 2023, we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. On the 17 January 2023, we carried out regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have served a notice to improve. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the action below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by the 3 February 2023

ensure risk assessments are effective, and all reasonable steps are taken to ensure children are not exposed to risk, with particular regard to equipment

ensure staffing arraignments meet the needs of all children, particularly during mealtimes

On the 09/02/2023 the provider sent us an improvement plan outlining what they have implemented to meet the above actions. The provider has updated their risk assessment processes and ensured all staff understand their responsibility in relation to this. The provider has also implemented new procedures during mealtimes to ensure children's safety.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

## **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services



we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.
