

## Compliance action taken for childcare provision

## **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 8 December 2022, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 13 January 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection.

We found that all staff have received training and have a sound understanding of safeguarding. They know about different types, signs and symptoms of abuse and understand the procedures to follow if they have any concerns about children. The provider maintains an accurate record of the vetting processes that have been completed for all staff, including details of the enhanced criminal records check obtained and all records are easily accessible and available. Arrangements for the supervision and monitoring of staff has improved. Staff receive regular opportunities to discuss sensitive issues and receive coaching and training opportunities to improve their teaching and personal effectiveness. All areas of the premises are clean, hygienic and fit for purpose. Appropriate support is provided for children with special educational needs and/or disabilities and children benefit from outdoor activities on a daily basis.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
