

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2).

If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 Sept 2022, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements, particularly in relation to notifications to Ofsted.

On 06 Feb 2023, we carried out a regulatory telephone call to gather further information from the provider. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements, particularly in relation to notifications to Ofsted.

On the 27 Feb 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take within the timescale set out below.

Actions needed by 27 March 2023

- improve knowledge and understanding of when to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the actions are successfully completed

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply

with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
