

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 24 January 2023 and 28 February 2023, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of the requirements.

On 16 March 2023, we carried out an unannounced regulatory visit. On 17 March 2023 we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found during the visit and telephone call that the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has now reviewed their risk assessment procedures. Additionally, we found the provider had failed to notify us of a significant event within the required timescales. On this occasion we took no further action as we believe the provider now understands what to notify Ofsted of and the required timescales.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to

bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
