

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). On 7 February 2023 we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The report and inspection outcome has been published. Following the inspection, we served a welfare requirements notice on 17 February 2023. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions as outlined in the report. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

On 27 February 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection. We found that the provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of child protection procedures and now fully understands their responsibilities.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
