

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 3 March 2023, we carried out a monitoring visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions set.

The provider responded to the actions set.

We found that the provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of ensuring the suitability of adults looking after children. The provider understands the procedures to follow to record and information on vetting processes, including criminal records checks and sharing appropriate information with Ofsted, in a timely manner. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
