

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 21 April 2023, the provider notified us of a significant event. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant changes or events.

On 2 May 2023, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider had not met some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right.

The provider has reviewed the risk assessment and procedures at mealtimes to ensure children are provided with visual cues that clearly identify their individual cups, cutlery, and plates. The provider has held professional discussions with staff to refresh their knowledge of allergies and the administering of an EpiPen. They have reminded every member of staff of the importance of following the nursery's food allergies, and nutrition and mealtime management policies and procedures, to ensure that the care of children with specific health needs are met.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
