

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 17 April 2023, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

The report and inspection outcome will be published in due course. Following the inspection, we served two welfare requirements notices. These are legal notices that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 19 April 2023:

- make sure staff are deployed effectively and supervise children appropriately to ensure children are safe and well care for

Action needed by 2 May 2023:

- improve the arrangements for the key person system to ensure that every child's individual needs are understood and met.

On 25 April 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare action due by the 19 April 2023, raised at their inspection.

At this visit we found that the provider had improved their deployment of staff to ensure children's safety. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare action raised.

On 5 May 2023, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. The focus of this call was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare action due by the 5 May 2023, raised at their inspection.

We found that the provider has employed more staff and informed parents of the new staff and the arrangements for allocating their child's key person. We are satisfied the provider

has met the safeguarding and welfare action raised.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
