

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 April 2023, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be not met. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 15 May 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare action, raised at their last inspection.

We found the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare action. The manager had organised staff training on the 'Prevent' duty. This had helped to improve staff's knowledge of the indicators associated with this type of abuse, which helps them to protect children from potential harm.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted
