

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundationstage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 April 2023, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On, 27 April 2023 we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have served a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed by 19 May 2023:

- ensure that all staff have up to date knowledge about local safeguarding procedures, so they know what to do if they have concerns about a child
- ensure that all staff have knowledge and understanding of the procedure to follow should they have concerns about the behaviour of a member of staff
- implement appropriate arrangements for the supervision of staff, with specific regard to the manager, to ensure their practice is monitored effectively and any training and support needs are identified.

On 25 May 2023 we carried out another regulatory visit to monitor the actions set. We found that all staff had improved their knowledge of local safeguarding procedures. They could all confidently describe the process they would follow should they have concerns about a child or about the behaviour of a member of staff. Appropriate arrangements have

also now been put in place for the supervision of the manager.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
