

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 10 May 2023, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of the requirements.

On 6 June 2023, we carried out an unannounced regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We served a welfare requirements notice on 9 June 2023. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. We have issued actions for the provider to take.

Actions needed by 16 June 2023

ensure a named deputy is always present at the setting in the manager's absence

ensure the setting's medication policy is followed, and that all medication is in date

ensure that medication forms are accurately filled in and parents informed

provide a suitable hygienic area for the preparation of food and drink, in particular preparing milk for babies



ensure accident records are completed accurately and parents informed about accident or injury that occurs at the setting

ensure children sleep safely in line with government safety guidance and that sleeping children are regularly checked to ensure they are safe

implement robust risk assessments to ensure children are kept safe, in particular reference to the outdoor environment.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
