

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 16 May 2023, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 13 June 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions and/or learning and development actions, raised at their last inspection. At the regulatory visit, we found that the provider had responded to the actions set. For instance, they have improved risk assessments, in particular fire safety procedures to ensure that children are able to evacuate safely in the event of a fire. In addition, they have taken action to improve security arrangements to prevent unauthorised people from being able to get access to the children. At the regulatory visit, we also found that the provider has taken action to ensure there is always a member of staff who holds paediatric first aid on site while children are present. The provider has also improved staffing arrangements to meet the staffing qualification requirements. Children's toilets are now maintained and clean for children to use. Children also have access to drinking water throughout the day. At the regulatory visit, we found that induction processes were now secure to ensure staff understand their roles and responsibilities. Staff also have access to ongoing training.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
