

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 03 May 2023, we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. On 18 May 2023 we carried out a regulatory visit and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take.

Actions needed by 02 June 2023

■ ensure staff are deployed effectively to meet needs of all children

Actions needed by 16 June 2023

- ensure key person approach is effective at meeting individual needs particularly those with special - educational needs and/or disabilities
- have more effective oversight of daily experiences for children ensuring all practitioners have appropriate skills and knowledge.

On 19 June 2023, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had taken action to ensure staff are deployed effectively. They ensured that the key person approach was meeting the needs of all children. The provider had developed their oversight of provision to ensure it is effective.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.



We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
