

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 5 May 2023, the provider notified us of a significant event. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted.

On 14 June 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 21 June 2023:

improve knowledge and update the written safeguarding policy to reflect the process to follow if an allegation is made against a household member

ensure information and records remain up to date, this includes maintaining an accurate record of all children's attendance

ensure Ofsted is kept updated with significant events as well as changes of arrangements to household members.

On the 16 June 2023, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider



had improved their knowledge and understanding of allegation management. The provider has reviewed processes to ensure information and records are kept up-to-date. Furthermore, the provider is now clear about ensuring Ofsted is notified of changes connected to the registration.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
