

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 10 May 2023, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 19 June 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection. We found that the provider had improved their knowledge of safer recruitment procedures and now fully understands their responsibilities, including completing vetting checks for all staff. The staff and manager are now receiving increased support from the committee, including an improvement in the quality of supervisions. The provider has also engaged with a mentor from an outstanding nursery in order to help staff develop their knowledge and skills in behaviour management. Additionally, the provider has been able to explain the links they have with parents and other providers which children attend, and how they use the information gathered to support children's development.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
